Starting Song	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Just like in previous cycles, the Starting Song is the moment for preparation of the Vivadi class. It is also necessary to carry out the playful tasks that the song proposes.</li></ul>
Narrative	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• That children feel like protagonists of their learning process by inviting them to engage as creators in a narration experience.</li><li>• To challenge the students to find agreements as a group through the process of choice making.</li></ul>
Action	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To engage in activities that follow the theme of the cycle: mystery</li></ul>
Harmony Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To let the children begin to embrace the postures they have been learning and start to play with them. Fewer poses are guided step by step.</li></ul>
Move Your Hips	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• That students gain confidence in singing songs in English</li></ul>
Ending Song	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To end the class in the same way it started.</li><li>• That children take responsibility for ordering their learning space and to make them feel owners of it.</li></ul>
