I LOVE YOU LIKE THE DRAGONFLY LOVES TO DANCE BALLET ON THE GUSTS OF THE BREEZE.




I LOVE YOU LIKE THE LADYBIRD LOVES TO LAND ON SOMEBODY'S COSY CARDIGAN.




